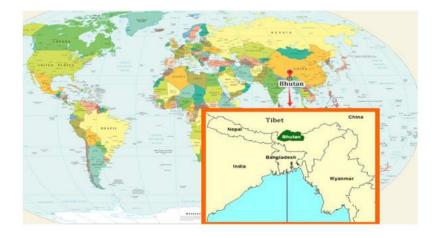

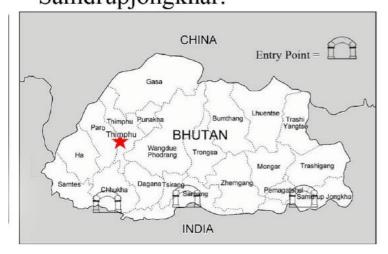

GENERAL INFORMATION

ACCESSIBILITY



Entry into Bhutan can be made either by Land or Air. Druk Air, the international airline of Bhutanopereates regular flight to/from Paro, Delhi, Kolkatta, Bagdogra Guwahati, Mumbai. By road the main entry to Bhutan is possibly through southern border. Phuntsholing, Gelephu and Samdrupjongkhar.



ENTRY PERMIT

For Indian Participants, either passport or Voter ID card is required to obtain the entry permit from immigration upon arrival at the airport or border checkposts. The organizer reccomends at atleast 14 days for submitting visa application and relevant documents.

HRAB shall facilitate the Participants to avail the permit upon confirmed participation for the event.
